Equine Safety Initiatives

Below are the Equine Safety Initiatives at Churchill Downs and how they affect you.

1. Rules And Conditions For Racing And Training Agreement: This must be signed and submitted to the Stable Office upon arrival. This agreement will cover all Kentucky CDI properties and must be renewed annually at the beginning of the Churchill Downs Spring Meet. Please make sure you and your veterinarian sign prior to turning it in.

- **2. Working After Placement On Veterinarian's List:** Trainer will not permit a horse placed on the Veterinarian's List to perform a high-speed (published) work for seven (7) days following placement on the Veterinarian's List.
- **3. Medication-Restricted Races:** Pursuant to the HISA Act, all two (2) year-old races and stakes races will be conducted Lasix-free. Please consult with your veterinarian, Churchill Downs Equine Medical Director (Dr. Farmer), or the KHRC if you have any questions regarding this regulation.
- **4. Shockwave Therapy Treatments:** All prescribed shockwave treatments require a 48 hour notice regardless of being done at the Equine Medical Center or requesting for treatment to be administered at the trainer's barn. Please contact Dr. Farmer to schedule. Following a shockwave treatment all horses are ineligible to have a high-speed work or race for 30 days. The Equine Medical Center is available daily from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m.. Trainers and Veterinarians violating this rule are subject to HISA penalties along with revocation of stalling privileges at CDI properties.
- **5. Pre-Entry Exam:** Pursuant to KHRC regulation, all horses must have an exam performed by your veterinarian within the three (3) days preceding a race entry. This exam is to be documented by your veterinarian and he/she will include their findings on their daily treatment records submitted to the KHRC.
- **6. Pre-Work Exam:** All horses stabled at Churchill Downs, Ellis Park, Trackside or Turfway Park must have an exam performed by your veterinarian within the five (5) days preceding a timed workout, per the rules and conditions for racing and training agreement. This exam is to be documented by your veterinarian and turned in to both KHRC and CD Equine Medical Director, Dr. Farmer.
- **7. Poor Performance:** Horses that are beaten by 12 lengths or more in five consecutive starts will be ineligible to race at any Churchill Downs property until approved by the Equine Medical Director to return.
- **8. Restricted Number of Starts:** Horses will be limited to four starts in a rolling eight-week period.
- **9. In-Today Signage:** All horses entered to race must be clearly identified starting at 7:30am on race day with an

"In-Today" sign. Trainers should hang these signs on the stall door or adjacent to the stall. This is separate from the KHRC Lasix tag hung following lasix administration. Extra signs are available in the Stable Office.

- **10. Entry Restrictions:** All 4-year-old and older first-time starters and any previously raced horse that has not raced in the previous 365 days must contact the KHRC veterinarians to schedule an official veterinary work PRIOR to entry. Any horse that has previously raced, but has not raced in the previous 150 days must contact the CDI Equine Medical Director PRIOR to entering the horse in a race. Any previously raced horse that has not raced in the previous 30 months is ineligible to train or race at any Churchill Downs Property, unless approved in advance by the CDI Equine Medical Director.
- **11. Waiver Claiming Rule:** Allows a trainer to enter a claiming race, but be ineligible to be claimed providing the horse has not started for a minimum of 120 days since its last race. And the horse is entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than the price at which it last started.

The digital tattooing fee is \$106. Fee must be paid at the time of service. Credit cards only please.

Rules and Conditions for Racing and Training at CDI Facilities

As a condition to, and in consideration for the undersigned trainer ("Trainer") being permitted to race, work, or train any horse at a Churchill Downs Incorporated ("CDI") owned facility, including, Churchill Downs Racetrack, Churchill Downs Training Center, Ellis Park or Turfway Park (each, a "Churchill Facility", and collectively, the "Churchill Facilities"), the Trainer and the undersigned Trainer's attending veterinarian ("Attending Veterinarian") hereby agree to be bound by the following conditions (the "Conditions"):

- 1. At all times, a horse must be in serviceable, sound racing condition in order to stable, race, work or train at a Churchill Facility. The Trainer acknowledges that it is his/ her obligation to (a) confirm the horse is in serviceable and sound racing condition, in order to stable, race, work or train on a Churchill Facility's grounds and (b) to inform the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/her authorized designee of any changes in the horse's fitness or health that would prevent a horse from stabling, racing, working or training on a Churchill Facility's grounds or any changes which would put Trainer, the Attending Veterinarian, or any horse in violation of these Conditions. Any horse that has not raced within thirty (30) months since its last start shall be presumed unsound to stable, race, work, or train at any Churchill Facility, unless approved in advance by the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/her authorized designee.
- 2. Trainer will not enter a horse in any race UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by Trainer's Attending Veterinarian during the three (3) days immediately preceding the close of entries for the selected race for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to race; and (b) been found fit to race by the Attending Veterinarian. This evaluation shall include, at a minimum, watching the horse jog and any other requirements set under any law, regulation, or house rule. The Attending Veterinarian and Trainer are each obligated to inform the CDI Equine Medical Director and the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission ("KHRC") official veterinarian or his/her designee of any changes in the horse's fitness after entry at any time prior to the race. The Racing Secretary, in consultation with the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/her authorized designee(s), may, but shall not be obligated to, consider any extenuating circumstances to the examination requirement of this rule on a case-by-case basis.
- 3. Trainer will not permit a horse stabled at or shipped in to a Churchill Facility to work UNLESS the horse has: (a) been examined by the Trainer's Attending Veterinarian during the five (5) days immediately preceding the work for the express purpose of evaluating the horse's fitness to work; and (b) been found fit to work by the Attending

Veterinarian (this evaluation shall include, at a minimum, watching the horse jog and any other requirements set under any law, regulations, or house rule). The Attending Veterinarian and Trainer are obligated to inform the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/her designee of any changes in the horse's fitness at any time after the examination set forth above and before the horse works.

- Trainer will not permit a horse placed on the Veterinarian's List to perform any high-speed (published) work for seven (7) days following placement on the Veterinarian's List.
- 5. Trainer will not enter in any race a horse that is a four-year old or older first time starteror a previously raced horse that has not raced in the 365 days preceding the date of the selected race UNLESS, in addition to the criteria set forth in Section 2 above and any other criteria set forth in any law, regulation, or house rule, such horse has completed an official work for the KHRC veterinarian or his/her designee prior to entry. The CDI Equine Medical Director may require evaluation(s) of any horse that has not raced within the one hundred fifty (150) days but have raced within the three hundred sixty-five (365) days preceding the date of the selected race. Based upon such evaluation, the CDI Equine Medical Director may (in his/her sole discretion) impose and require the horse to meet any additional requirements prior to being able to enter. Based upon that examination, the CDI Equine Medical Director may require the horse to work prior to being allowed to enter. If the horse is required to work under this provision, it must meet the same requirements as a horse that is working off of the KHRC's Veterinarian's list.
- 6. Trainer will not enter in a race: (a) any horse that has finished twelve (12) or more lengths behind the winner in each of its last five (5) starts, or (b) any horse that has raced greater than four (4) times in the fifty-six (56) days immediately preceding the race date.
- 7. Under no circumstances shall an examination conducted by a veterinarian who has NOT been identified as the Trainer's Attending Veterinarian under these Conditions constitute a valid examination for purposes of determining a horse's fitness to race, work or train.
- 8. The Churchill Facilities and the CDI Equine Medical Director or his/her authorized designee(s) are entitled (but not obligated) to contact, without prior notice, Trainer's Attending Veterinarian to confirm that examinations have been conducted pursuant to these Conditions and that any such examination meets the applicable Churchill Facility's requirements. The Churchill Facilities and the CDI Equine Medical Director shall have the right (but not the obligation) to examine and review all records of examinations performed in accordance with these Conditions, and Trainer agrees that the applicable Churchill Facility or the CDI Equine Medical Director may inspect and copy for

each's own use, and Trainer shall provide upon request, all documents, electronic or otherwise, containing reports by official racing veterinarians of pre-race examinations, postrace examinations (including without limitation necropsy reports) and/or any records of procedures required by regulatory agencies or under applicable industry safety accreditation organizations of Trainer's horse(s) racing or training at each Churchill Facility.

- 9. All horses stabled or entered to race at a Churchill Facility, or present on a Churchill Facility's grounds, are subject to: (a) veterinary inspections and requests for veterinary medical records by the CDI Equine Medical Director, or his/her designee and (b) veterinary monitoring. Trainer, Trainer's staff, and Attending Veterinarians will cooperate fully with all requests made by CDI veterinarians and the applicable Churchill Facility's staff.
- 10. As used herein, the term "Attending Veterinarian" shall include the undersigned veterinarian and any veterinarian who is a member of his/her veterinary practice.
- 11. If stabled on a Churchill Facility's grounds, both Trainer and the Attending Veterinarian will abide by all rules and regulations of the applicable Churchill Facility, including, without limitation, House Rules (including those relating to equine welfare and integrity), or other rules (including, without limitation, all rules set forth in the applicable Churchill Facility's Condition Book, Stall Application, the Rules of the Barn Area, and the Rules of the Track), all of which are hereby expressly incorporated by reference herein. Trainer and Attending Veterinarian shall be responsible for obtaining and becoming familiar with such rules and regulations.
- 12. All KHRC licensees, including but not limited to each Churchill Facility, owners, trainers, jockeys, and grooms ("licensees"), participating in stabling, racing, training, and related activities at the Churchill Facilities recognize that hazards and risks inherent in such activities may cause the injury or death of horses. Therefore, in consideration of participating in stabling, racing, training, and related activities at a Churchill Facility, all licensees assume the risks of, and release, hold harmless and covenant not to sue all other licensees so participating for: (i) Ordinary negligence which causes or contributes to loss, loss of use, injury or damage to horses while on the premises of such Churchill Facility; and (ii) Ordinary negligence which causes or contributes to personal injury or property damage, including but not limited to loss, loss of use, injury or damage to horses arising from the use of grass fields or gallops owned or controlled by such Churchill Facility, whether arising from alleged acts or omissions of a licensee and its agents or employees, the condition of the premises of such Churchill Facility or any other cause. Except as provided above, all licensees participating in

racing, training, and related activities at a Churchill Facility shall be responsible for their own acts and omissions and those of their agents and employees to the same extent as provided by law. The foregoing provisions shall be construed in a manner consistent with the limitations set forth herein to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and the KHRC's regulations and shall be binding upon Trainer, its successors and/or assignees. The maintenance by CDI or any of its subsidiaries of insurance shall not affect the terms or interpretation of this Agreement. The foregoing release shall extend to CDI's and its subsidiaries' officers, directors, agents, employees, contractors, servants and licensees. In the event of any inconsistency between these provisions and the KHRC's regulations, the KHRC's regulations shall control. Further, these provisions shall be deemed to be amended to the extent of, and to be in compliance with, any amendment to the KHRC's regulations.

- 13. Both Trainer and Attending Veterinarian will abide by all rules and regulations of the KHRC and the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority ("HISA"), at any time expressly incorporated by reference herein, and the rules and regulations of the KHRC or HISA, at any time adopted or as they may be amended. Trainer and Attending Veterinarian shall be responsible for obtaining and becoming familiar with such rules and regulations. Ignorance of such rules and regulations shall not be considered a defense for non-compliance therewith.
- 14. Any failure by CDI or a Churchill Facility to enforce any terms or conditions of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver by such Churchill Facility, and shall not affect or impair this Agreement in any way, or the right of CDI at any time to enforce this Agreement. A Churchill Facility representative's approval or consent to any action proposed by Trainer or Attending Veterinarian shall not (a) waive Trainer or Attending Veterinarian's obligation to strictly comply with this Agreement, or (b) be construed as an undertaking of Churchill Facility, the CDI Equine Medical Director, or any other designee or either such party to treat, diagnose, or otherwise be responsible for the condition of any horse.
- 15. Both Trainer and the Attending Veterinarian understand and acknowledge that these Conditions shall be in effect annually commencing on the date of the opening of the Churchill Downs Racetrack stable area prior to the Churchill Downs Racetrack Spring Meet (or any successor meet therefor) each year and continuing through the conclusion of the Turfway Park Winter/ Spring Meet (or any successor meet therefor) the following year, and for Trainers that have horse(s) on a Churchill Facility's grounds, these Conditions shall be in effect from earliest date noted below and for so long as Trainer has horse(s) on such Churchill Facility's grounds.

By signing below, the Attending Veterinarian acknowledges and agrees that he/she (a) is the Attending Veterinarian for the undersigned Trainer, (b) has read and fully understands the above Conditions and agrees to be bound by them, (c) will consult with the CDI Equine Medical Director if he/she has any questions regarding such Conditions, and (d) will comply fully with the Conditions.

Any change in the party that will be acting as the Trainer's Attending Veterinarian requires Trainer and the new Attending Veterinarian to submit a fully executed copy of these Conditions to CDI Equine Medical Director.



After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to the second, 10% to the third, 5% to the fourth and 3% to the fifth.

Entries

Entries close at 10:30 a.m.. Entry closing dates are listed at the top of each page of conditions. Riders must be named by the closing of entries.

Scratch Times

Scratch time is 8:00 a.m. on race day. Twilight/Night Racing must scratch by 11:00 p.m. on race day. Scratches will be considered by the stewards upon submission.

Workout Procedures

Please submit to the gap attendants' horse's name, distance and trainer's name before entering the track. If the gap attendants are unavailable, you may text necessary information to 502-322-3109. This number is ONLY available during training hours. Please do not use any of the clockers' personal cell phone numbers.

Turf Course

All races scheduled to run on the turf course may, in the event of a change in the condition of the course, be transferred and run over the main track. All races transferred from the turf course to the main track will be run at the same distance, except that races at one mile and threeeighths will be contested at one mile and a quarter on the main track. Races run at one mile will be contested at one mile out of the chute on the main track. Ponies will not be allowed on the turf course.

Out Of Competition Testing

Pursuant to 810 KAR 8:040, the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission (the "KHRC") is authorized to conduct "out of competition" testing on any horse that is eligible, or that may become eligible, to race in Kentucky. A horse is eligible to race in Kentucky if it is under the care, custody or control of a trainer licensed by the KHRC; or is owned by an owner licensed by the KHRC; or is nominated to a race at an association licensed by the KHRC; or has raced at an association licensed by the KHRC within the previous twelve calendar months; or is stabled on the grounds of an association or training center subject to the jurisdiction of the KHRC; or is nominated to participate in the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund.

The KHRC is authorized to test for blood doping agents, venoms and their derivatives, and growth hormones. The regulation also prohibits possession of the foregoing substances, as well as whole blood or packed red blood cells, on the grounds of an association or training facility subject to jurisdiction of the KHRC. A horse designated for testing must be made available for sampling at a mutually agreedupon location within six hours of notification that it has been designated for testing. If a horse is not made available for testing, or if there is any other failure to cooperate with the KHRC, the individual(s) responsible will be penalized to the full extent allowed by the regulation. If a horse tests positive for a prohibited substance, the owner and trainer are notified of the test results, and the horse is placed on the Veterinarian's List pending a steward's hearing.

The owner and/or trainer have the right to split sample analysis, as set forth in 810 KAR 1:018/811 KAR 1:090. If the positive finding is confirmed, serious penalties shall be imposed, including but not limited to, the revocation of the violator's license for a period of five to ten years. The regulation can be found in its entirety at: khrc.ky.gov.

Date Preference System

The Date System of preference will be used at Churchill Downs as described below:

Foal Certificates and digital foal certificates no longer are required to be on file in the racing office to enter or start at Churchill Downs; however, foal certificates and digital foal certificates must be on file to obtain a preference date and to get a horse tattooed.

Each day's overnight will list the dates of horses in and on the also-eligible list to enable trainers to see what dates are getting horses in over-filled races.

1. In over-filled races, preference will be given to horses in order of their assigned preference dates, earliest date first. Horses having identical dates will be chosen by lot, however, where entry and running dates are the same, the horse with the entry date will have preference.

- 2. All horses intended for racing at Churchill Downs will be assigned a preference date. Dates assigned will be of two types:
- 3. For a zero date foal papers and digital foal papers must be turned in to the identifier by 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday, April 23, 2024.

E-DATE

This date will correspond to:

- a) The day on which a horse's foal papers or digital foal papers are submitted to the identifier (the earliest date being the day when entries are first taken for the meeting). An unnamed horse will not receive an E-date.
- b) The day on which a horse is first entered if his papers or digital foal papers are not on file with the identifier.

To qualify for the latter E-date, a horse must have been excluded from a race which appears on the overnight or he must have been entered in a condition book race which failed to fill through insufficient entries.

R-DATE

This date will correspond to the day of a horse's most recent race at Churchill Downs. An R-Date will also be assigned to a horse which scratches.

- 4. A horse retains his R-Date until he receives a newer R-Date. No horse with an established R-Date may receive an E-Date. A horse whose papers or digital papers are removed from the identifier's office will lose his date and must subsequently re-establish a date in order to receive preference. A horse with an E-Date cannot receive a newer E-Date. Horses starting at another race track will forfeit any date they may have at Churchill Downs.
- 5. Preference dates will consist of two categories: Dirt (D) and Turf (T). Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance.
- 6. A horse that runs in a race, which has been taken off the turf will retain its turf date. A scratched horse will receive an R-date from the date scratched.
- 7. When a race is taken off the turf, main track only (MTO) horses will receive an R-Date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the turf, main track only (MTO) horses will retain their previous date and will not be permitted to start.
- 8. No E-Date will be assigned to the second choice of an unsplit same-owner entry.
- 9. A horse which has been placed on a list (veterinarian, steward, starter or paddock judge) will lose their date and be assigned an R-Date corresponding to the day removed from list.
- 10. A horse which is a scheduled starter in a canceled race will not receive an R-Date for that race but will retain its previous date.

- 11. The draw of stakes and handicap race is not subject to date preference.
- 12. Preference dates are transferred through change of ownership and changes in trainer after the proper transfer procedure have been completed through the Steward's office and delivered to the Racing Secretary's office.
- 13. Date preference rules will not supersede KHRC rules regarding preference, eligibility or scratches.
- 14. Winners will be preferred in all non maiden races.

CONDITION PREFERENCE

Horses are preferred by their available conditions in all allowance races beginning with Graded Stakes winners (Grade I-II-III), down through their allowance conditions (when the allowance conditions are equal an open stakes winner shall be preferred) providing the horse has finished 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th for \$50,000 or more since starting for less than \$50,000. In allowance/optional claiming races, a horse's preference cannot exceed the condition of the race. Starter races for less than \$40,000 will not be preferred.

Winners are preferred in all non-maiden races.

Also-eligibles: If there are any scratches in a race with alsoeligibles, the also-eligible horses will be permitted to move into the race in the order listed on the overnight.

810 KAR 4:010. HORSES

The stewards may at any time require presentation of a horse's registration certificate, virtual certificate, or racing permit or other proof of ownership.

Upon claim, sale or any other transfer of ownership, the horse's registration cerificate or racing permit shall be given to the new owner, and any virtual certificate shall be transferred to the new owner electronically. The new owner shall report the change in ownership to the stewards.

The Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund (KTDF)

With robust business since inception of the state-of-the-art historical racing machines at nearby Derby City Gaming and Derby City Gaming Downtown, tens of millions of dollars have been generated in KTDF for horsemen with Kentucky-sired Kentucky-breds to run for in designated stakes, handicap, allowance, non-claiming maiden races and allowance optional claiming races with a claiming price of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) contested at Churchill Downs Racetrack. Continuing in Spring 2024, Churchill Downs Racetrack will offer KTDF money on all claiming races.

Eligible races can be readily recognized in the stakes and condition books by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund seal, which will appear next to each race in the stakes and condition books.

In accordance with KRS 230.400(5) (d), it is mandatory for a horse to be registered prior to time of entry to be eligible to participate in the distribution of Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund monies. Registration is only complete once the application is approved and payment has been received.

All horses of racing age that are both Kentucky-bred and sired by a Kentucky stallion which stood in Kentucky the entire breeding season the year the horse was conceived are eligible to be registered. Owners of horses of racing age are responsible for registering their horses. Stallion owners are responsible for registering their stallions

The Horse Identifier can check registration status of a horse.

For those horses that are registered and eligible according to the conditions listed above, fund monies will be divided as follows:

- 60% to the winner
- 20% to second
- 10% to third
- 5% to fourth
- 3% to fifth

Remaining 2% is to be divided among starters based on the schedule listed above.

Unearned fund monies revert to the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund. Additionally, if a non-KTDF eligible horse is involved in a dead heat, those funds will revert to the fund.

Please note: all KTDF purse allotments contained herein are subject to KHRC approval.

ALLOCATION OF FUND BASED ON NUMBER OF STARTERS & FINISH

For those horses that are registered and eligible according to the condition listed above, fund monies will be divided as follows: 60% to the winner, 20% to the second, 10% to the third, 5% to the fourth, 3% to the fifth and the remaining 2% to be allocated among sixth through last based on the schedule below.

Ship-Ins

There will be no ship-in training at Churchill Downs or Trackside. Entrant agrees that any horse running at Churchill Downs will be on the grounds a minimum of $4 \frac{1}{2}$ hours prior to race time. Failure to have the horse in its assigned stall on time will result in disciplinary action by the stewards. All horses, including lead ponies, seeking entrance to the stable area shall be accompanied by a current negative EIA Test (aka Coggins) and be listed on a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) with the examination and issuance of the certificate being signed and dated by a licensed veterinarian within 72 hours prior to arrival. Additionally, each horse seeking entrance to our stable area shall be vaccinated against Equine Herpesvirus Type 1 (EHV-1) by a licensed veterinarian a minimum of 14 days and no more than 120 days prior to entry into our stable area. Once a horse receives the initial EHV-1 vaccination, re-vaccination is required every 120 days. For example, if a horse was vaccinated in January, he/she is required to be vaccinated at least every 120 days while stabled at the track. The minimum 14 day vaccine requirement applies only to horses that have not been vaccinated for EHV-1 during the preceding 120 days. For each horse, the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) shall indicate the date of the horse's vaccination and the specific vaccine product used.

Unapproved Advertising and Ambush Marketing

Unless previously approved in writing by Churchill Downs, the display of marketing or advertising materials anywhere within the Churchill Downs facility is prohibited. This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, (i) the unauthorized display or use of signs, banners, mascots or other items with the names, logos, emblems, slogans, or trademarks of any company unaffiliated with Churchill Downs; (ii) providing promotional items for any company without Churchill Downs' approval; (iii) any coordinated effort to promote any brand (including by way of clothing) while on Churchill Downs' property; or (iv) any other attempt to suggest that a brand or company is affiliated with or endorsed by Churchill Downs. Churchill Downs may request the removal of the unauthorized marketing or advertising materials and may expel any person who violates this prohibition. Furthermore, Churchill Downs expressly reserves the right to pursue any legal remedies to the extent the unauthorized marketing activities violate Churchill Downs' legal rights.

Workout Rule

810 KAR 4:030, ENTRIES, SUBSCRIPTIONS AND DECLARATIONS

Section 3, Subsection 8, (A), (B) and (C)

(8) (a) A horse that has not started in the past forty-five (45) days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least one (1) published workout within twenty (20) days of entry at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workout, but the workout does not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workout failed to be published through no fault of the trainer.

(b) A horse that has not started in the past ninety (90) days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least two (2) published workouts during the past ninety (90) day period, one of which occurs within twenty (20) days of entry at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workouts, but the workouts do not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workout failed to be published through no fault of the trainer.

(c) A horse that has not started in the past 180 days shall not be permitted to start unless it has at least three (3) published workouts during the past 180-day period, one (1) of which occurs within twenty (20) days of entry, at a distance satisfactory to the stewards. If a horse has performed the requisite workouts, but the workouts do not appear in the past performances, the horse shall be permitted to start if the stewards determine that the workouts failed to be published through no fault of the trainer.

(d) A horse starting for the first time shall not be permitted to start unless it has three (3) workouts, one (1) of which is from the starting gate, one (1) of which is within twenty (20) days of entry, and at least one (1) of which is published.

(e) A workout not appearing in the official program shall be publicly displayed on television monitors, the tote board, and, if available, the bulletin boards where photo finishes are shown at the time when mutuel windows are opened and shall be displayed until the conclusion of the race in which the horse is entered.

Track Rules

Owners or trainers will be required to deposit jockey fees (except for those under contract with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper) no later than one hour prior to the first race on the day of the race. Exceptions to this rule are to be by arrangement of credit in advance. Monies deposited with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper for the purpose of claiming a horse must be in cash or a certified or cashier's check. No entry will be received except upon the condition that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with the respect to the interpretation of the conditions of any race shall be decided by the Officers of this Association or those whom they appoint, and their decision upon all points shall be final. All two-year-olds must be properly schooled and approved by the starter before being allowed to start.

Every horse must be saddled in the paddock. This rule is imperative. Horses must be in the paddock at least twenty minutes before the scheduled post time. The stewards reserve the right to substitute one jockey for another at their discretion. It will be their purpose to substitute a jockey of equal ability.

EQUINE DRUG TESTING

All winning horses will be subjected to HISA's testing standards, which are approved by TOBA, for the presence of performance-enhancing drugs. Churchill Downs may participate in a program to freeze and store blood and urine samples so that retrospective testing may be done in the event that suspicious circumstances arise.

BAN ON HORSE SLAUGHTER

Any owner or trainer who directly or indirectly participates in the transport or sale of a horse previously stabled at a CDI property to a slaughter facility or to an auction that facilitates the sale of horses for slaughter shall permanently forfeit all stabling and racing privileges at any CDI property.

GELDING & GENDER, 810 KAR 4:010, SECTION 12

Trainers must promptly report all horses gelded to the horse identifier or the racing office. Trainers will be held responsible for not reporting the correct gender of their horse at the time of entry. Failure to comply shall result in disciplinary action by the stewards.

TURF RACE ENTRIES

In an effort to ensure that racing fans will have an opportunity to wager on a reasonable number of horses, the following policies are in place concerning turf entries. Entries will be accepted in turf races (excluding stakes) for Main Track Only (MTO) horses. Trainers must declare the horse as MTO at time of entry. A horse entered as MTO shall be listed as an Also-Eligible. In an over-filled turf race, an MTO shall not be carded to the exclusion of a turf entry, and Also-Eligibles (including MTO) shall be assigned a post position by preference. If preference is equal, post positions shall be drawn by lot, unless otherwise stipulated in the published conditions of the race. If the race remains on the turf, a horse listed as MTO shall not be permitted to draw into the race. When a race is removed from the turf, MTO horses will receive an R-Date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the turf, MTO horses will retain their previous date. Churchill Downs reserves the right to add up to 8 AE's and MTO's to all overnight races.

ADDITIONAL SAFETY REGULATIONS

Other safety regulations that will be strictly enforced include prohibitions on smoking in the track's barns and rules against the jogging of horses on the inner rail during training hours. The use of grills in the track's barns will also be closely monitored.

GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

Trainer shall maintain at all times general liability insurance with coverage no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, and \$2,000,000 in the aggregate. Trainer shall also maintain at all times Worker's Compensation insurance covering all personnel employed as required by statute. Trainer shall, prior to admission to Churchill's Facilities and at any time upon request by Churchill, furnish a certificate evidencing proof of insurance coverage in accordance with the requirements set forth herein. Responsibility for the maintenance of appropriate horse mortality or other equine insurance rests with the trainer and/or Owner(s), as the case may be and as agreed between those parties, and **Churchill Downs shall have no obligation with respect to**

Consultation with a competent insurance advisor is strongly recommended. Failure to maintain adequate insurance may subject Trainer and/or Owner(s) to multiple and substantial risks, including being excluded from Churchill's premises. All certificates of insurance shall provide that Churchill shall receive at least thirty days advance notice by the insurer of any cancellation or material change in coverage. Owner(s) and Trainer indemnify and hold Churchill harmless against any claims, liabilities, judgments, or costs (including attorney fees) arising out of the Trainer and/or Owner(s)' failure to obtain insurance as appropriate and as may be required by law.

LIVE RACING CHECK REQUESTS:

Purse funds are available two business days after the race (a business day is considered a live race day). Funds may be requested in person, by phone or email and a photo I.D. must be provided. Check requests for same day pick-up must be made before 11:00 a.m. Any check requests made after 11:00 a.m. will be available on the next business day.

POST LIVE MEET DISBURSEMENTS:

Transfers: Owners may elect to have funds transferred to another track. In this instance, Owners should notify the bookkeeper of the desired transfer location prior to the last day of the meet. Due to the volume of requests, it may take two business days to complete the transfer.

Remaining Fund Balances: If, after the Spring or Fall race meeting funds remain on account, the bookkeeping office will send remaining funds via check to the address on file unless the required information above has not been received. After the September race meeting, funds are held unless a transfer is requested.

AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS

Due to additional bank fraud protection services, checks issued by the bookkeeper may not be immediately available to exchange for cash at a bank teller window. If planning to cash these checks at a bank teller window within 24 hours of disbursement, you must notify the bookkeeper when requesting the check. The bookkeeping office will work in good faith to expedite the funds for immediate cashing when requested by the customer.

General Conditions

Entries to any race are received only upon the condition that the Applicant agrees to and will comply with the rules and regulations governing Thoroughbred horse races adopted by the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission (the "KHRC") and the rules and regulations of Churchill Downs Incorporated ("Churchill") (including these conditions) and will comply with and abide by any decision of the state racing officials and/ or the Officers of Churchill regarding the interpretation and application of such rules and regulations.

Applicant consents and agrees to all provisions of Churchill's current application and/or agreements regarding the use of stall space, the terms of which are specifically incorporated herein by reference, and shall execute all such applications and/or agreements before bringing any horse upon Churchill's grounds. In making this application to participate in thoroughbred racing, Applicant agrees and consents to Churchill and/or its agents making an investigation of Applicant whereby information may be requested from third parties as to character, general reputation, personal characteristics, mode of living, or such other information as may be relevant to the Applicant's integrity as a racing participant. Churchill reserves the right to cancel any race, without notice, at any time prior to the actual running thereof, without liability except for the return of all fees as required by the rules of racing. Churchill reserves the right to make all decisions regarding preferences and conditions and its decision shall be final.

Nominations are received only with the understanding that Churchill reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion to refuse, cancel or revoke any nomination, entry or stall application or the transfer thereof and reserves the right to deny the right to start in a race without notice to the Applicant and for any reason, including but not limited to the Applicant's failure to fully perform or abide by all provisions and conditions hereof.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

A. In consideration of the Applicant's admission to Churchill's facility, the Applicant hereby releases Churchill from all claims for loss or damage of, or injury to, or death of any persons or property (including horses as well as loss of use of property) sustained by the Applicant and/or its invitees and/or the property owned or under the control of the Applicant located at Churchill's facilities. The Applicant recognizes the risks of its activities to be undertaken at Churchill's facilities and it has inspected and is familiar with Churchill's facilities and does voluntarily and fully assume all risk of loss, injury, damage, death or destruction to any person or property. This release and assumption of risk provision shall not be effective as to any cause of loss attributable to any intentional, willful, grossly negligent, or reckless conduct of Churchill. The Applicant further agrees to protect, indemnify and hold harmless Churchill (or if indemnification is not available, to contribute to Churchill's losses) from and against any loss, damage, claims or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' and other fees), arising directly or indirectly from any acts or omissions of the Applicant, or any of the Applicant's horses, or any agent, employee or invitee of the Applicant, arising out of or in connection with the Applicant's activities at Churchill's facilities.

B. The foregoing provisions shall be construed in a manner consistent with the limitations set forth herein to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and the KHRC's regulations and shall be binding upon Applicant, its successors and/or assignees. The maintenance by Churchill of insurance shall not affect the terms or interpretation of this Agreement. For purposes of this Agreement, Churchill shall mean and include Churchill and its officers, directors, agents, employees, contractors, servants and licensees. In the event of any inconsistency between these provisions and KHRC's regulations, the KHRC's regulations shall control. Further, these provisions shall be deemed to be amended to the extent of, and to be in compliance with, any amendment to the KHRC's regulations. Trainer shall, prior to its admission to Churchill's facilities, deliver to the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission certificates evidencing the maintenance of Worker's Compensation Insurance for all employed personnel in accordance with the statutory requirements of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Responsibility for the maintenance of general liability and horse mortality insurance to cover the risks outlined above vests with the Applicant. Consultation with a competent insurance advisor is strongly recommended. Failure to maintain adequate insurance may subject the Applicant to the risks outlined above.

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

As the organizer, host and sponsor of thoroughbred horse races, Churchill hereby reserves unto itself, its agents, assigns and licensees and Applicant hereby assigns to Churchill all interest it may have in the Host Rights, as herein defined. The Host Rights shall mean the sole and exclusive right to: (a) produce, exhibit, sell, license, transfer or transmit in any manner still or motion pictures, radio and television broadcasts, or any other media transmission, now known or hereafter developed, of all events which occur on Churchill's property, including without limitation, all activities occurring before, during and after thoroughbred horse races; (b) utilize the race and the results thereof, all for any purpose or use as Churchill shall determine; (c) limit, prohibit or regulate the display of any commercial advertising symbols, or other identification, other than Applicant's registered silks, in connection with any race or related activities; and

(d) develop, produce and sell, by or through any licensee, goods using the Applicant's name or likeness, the name or likeness of any horse owned by the Applicant brought onto Churchill's grounds, or any other identifying feature, silks, trademark or copyrighted material which is used in connection with the race. The submission of a nomination or making of any entry in any race shall mean that the Applicant consents to the above reservation of the Host Rights and consents to be photographed or to otherwise by a subject of still or moving pictures, radio or television programs, without remuneration except for contributions to horsemen's purses from wagering on the races as established by contract or legislation. The Applicant agrees that he has not and will not execute any documents or take any other action which purports to assign or otherwise transfer any interest in the Host Rights or assert any claim, demand or cause of action against Churchill which is inconsistent with the full and exclusive exercise by Churchill of its Host Rights.

DEFINITION OF APPLICANT

As used herein, "Applicant" shall mean and include the owners. trainers, jockeys of the horse being entered (and if Applicant is an agent/assistant to any Applicant, the principal for whom he is agent), and their heirs, representatives, successors, next of kin and assigns; provided, however, that the rights and benefits of the Applicant under this Agreement are personal and no such right or benefits shall be subject to voluntary or involuntary alienation, assignment or transfer. Applicant covenants that all of the above parties have agreed to the foregoing conditions and further agrees that it will deliver their written consent and agreement to such conditions upon request of Churchill. Applicant shall indemnify and hold Churchill harmless from and against any claim or cause of action (including any expense incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable attorney's fees and other fees) that may be asserted by or on behalf of any person which is inconsistent with the release and indemnification provisions set forth in the foregoing paragraphs.

Equine Injury Database

Churchill Downs Incorporated ("CDI") and each of its racetracks has entered into an Equine Injury Database Agreement with The Jockey Club ("TJC") to implement one of TJC's Thoroughbred Safety Committee recommendations regarding tracking of equine injuries occurring at any of its racetrack facilities. Trainer, on behalf of himself and as agent for each Owner listed in the Stall Application submitted by Trainer, agrees that accurate tracking of equine injuries is an important step toward improving the safety of horse racing and by accepting the use of certain stalls at Churchill Downs, gives its consent to the collection of information related to any injury occurring at Churchill Downs to a horse owned or trained by Trainer and entry of said information into a database maintained by TJC and its affiliated businesses (including InCompass Solutions, Inc. [the "Equine Injury Database"]) by Churchill Downs and/or the Kentucky Horse Racing Commissionemployed Veterinarian (the "Veterinarian") with respect to any injury occurring at Churchill Downs to a horse owned or trained by Trainer.

For purposes of this consent, "injury" shall include, but is not limited to, an injury to a horse that is (i) scratched at the recommendation of the examining Veterinarian; (ii) determined to be injured/unsound/in distress, or otherwise unfit in the paddock, post parade, starting gate, during or immediately after the running of the race; (iii) observed to be injured unsound or in distress in the Detention Barn, or as a result of a Veterinarian's post-race inspection; (iv) scratched for medical reason not documented by the Veterinarian (e.g., trainer reports sick, injured, colic, tied-up, fever, etc.); or (v) injured during training or in non-race related events.

Collectively, Churchill Downs, the Veterinarian, TJC and its affiliated businesses and the owners, stewards, directors, officers, employees and agents of any of the aforementioned persons and entities may be referred to as the "Indemnified Parties."

Trainer, on behalf of himself and as agent for each Owner listed in the Stall Application submitted by Trainer, further agrees to cooperate in the disclosure of such information to the extent that such cooperation is reasonably required and covenants not to sue and, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, to indemnify, release and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties from and against any liability, cost, loss, or expense of any kind of nature (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) arising from any claim, demand, or action (a) alleging that the data entered into the Equine Injury Database (either directly or indirectly) violates the rights of Applicant or any third party, or (b) relating to any equine injury report run, published or otherwise created by any of the Indemnified Parties (either directly or indirectly). 


