Dear Horsemen,
First and foremost, thank you for your continued patience and cooperation as we try to navigate through these times. As many of you probably know, Churchill Downs will be conducting the Fall Race Meet with a limited number of racing fans and spectators but in doing so we are required to follow very specific guidelines set forth by state and local health officials. In an attempt to be compliant with some of these guidelines, we had to implement new policies and new procedures for the Fall Meet. After a few days of being open and gathering feedback we have made a few adjustments to the plan that we wanted to communicate to you all as well as remind you of other protocols that are still in effect.

1. Entry into the Facility for Racing
a. One of the guidelines that we are operating under calls for Churchill Downs to have the names and information of all individuals entering the facility. After gathering feedback from the first few days, we understand this process caused some delays for horsemen attempting to enter the facility from the Paddock Gate. In an effort to correct that, Steve Hargrave has 2 Horsemen Entry Passes for each trainer. These passes will allow horsemen to bypass the ticketing window and directly enter the facility at the paddock gate entrance. There is also a designated section of parking directly in front of the gate that is being held for horsemen coming over to race or claim. Stop by the Stable Office to pick up the Horsemen Entry Passes. The passes are good for each day of racing and just need to be scanned upon entry at the gate. Alternatively, Horsemen may drive through over from the barn area through the infield tunnel and park in an area under the grandstand on the front side.

2. Paddock Access
a. The Paddock access protocols from Spring and September are still in effect for the Fall Race Meet. Two (2) owners per horse and (Four) 4 trainer staff members are allowed to access the paddock area during racing. These same individuals should be the only individuals in the Winner's Circle as well. Ownership groups with multiple members are encouraged to socially distance themselves around the paddock apron area for paddock viewing.

3. Backside Mask Enforcement
a. As a reminder, face coverings should be worn at all times while on Churchill Downs property. Churchill Downs Security will be monitoring the backside area and enforcing the mask policy. Please remind your staff to be vigilant about properly wearing their masks when in and around the barn area.

We are in the homestretch of racing and training here in Louisville and we greatly appreciate all of you and your team members efforts in helping us safely operate these racing meets. We are asking for you and your staff to maintain your vigilance and continue your safety practices as we near the finish line.

-All riders currently riding at Keeneland and have not left the state of Kentucky will be permitted to ride without the need of further testing.
Jockeys coming from out-of-state
-Any jockey coming to ride from out-of-state must provide a gold standard RT-PCR COVID-19 nasopharyngeal test taken no later than 72 hours before arriving at Churchill Downs. Send test results to covidtesting@kyderby.com when available. Rapid, non RT-PCR Tests WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
oNote - Jockeys coming in to the ride the Breeders' Cup may submit their test for the Breeders' Cup to Churchill Downs.
oThese riders will use the auxiliary jockeys' room when riding at Churchill Downs.
-Any jockey that has been cleared to ride but then leaves to ride at another

track out-of-state will be required to provide another gold standard RT-PCR COVID-19 nasopharyngeal test taken no later than 72 hours before their next mount at Churchill Downs.

Jockey Protocols

-Jockeys should continue to practice social distancing measures and follow all protocols.

-Jockeys are required to wear masks at all times EXCEPT when riding in the race or during a timed workout in the morning. This includes when in the paddock pre-race, while being ponied to post and after the race on the walk back to the Jockeys' Room.

ONLY 4 PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED TO COME TO THE PADDOCK WITH A HORSE FOR THEIR RACE.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: The stewards shall not void the claim if, prior to the race in which the horse is claimed, the claimant indicates on the claim blank that he or she elects to claim the horse regardless of whether or not the commission veterinarian determines the horse will be placed on the Veterinarian's List as bled, unsound or lame.

ATTENTION HORSEMEN: All Schooling vest should be left at the end of the tunnel in the vest bin.

HORSEMEN- Tattoos are payable immediately on the arrival of technicians or the TRPB technician will not start to examine the horse. Additionally, all bandages must be off and legs clean. The new "Digital Tattoo System" requires a series of photographs to be taken.
